



Thomas Edison is one of the most important inventors in our modern history. He was from **USA**. He was born in **1847**. Thomas Edison couldn't go to school due to his health problems, so he studied at home. When he was thirteen, he began a job selling candy, newspapers, and vegetables **on a train**. He used the money he made to buy equipment and tools for experiments. few years later, Edison moved to New York and began to work for a company fixing their machines. At night, he continued to work on his projects. He invented and developed many devices like power generators and sound recorders, but his most famous and important invention was the **light bulb**. In his free time Edison enjoyed **reading**. He died on October 18, 1931due to a disease called diabetes. He was buried behind his home.
